What is Lent?



This Wednesday begins the season of Lent, a 40-day countdown to Easter, intended to symbolize the 40 day temptation of Jesus in the wilderness (e.g. Matthew 4). Lent is a season of preparation as we look and move toward Jesus' last week prior to the crucifixion and resurrection, where we celebrate days such as Good Friday and Easter. Traditionally, Christians take up practices during Lent which symbolize repentance, such as fasting. More important than our works, however, is remembering Jesus' work on our behalf. Lent is a great period to continually reflect on the fact that Jesus not only died for us, He lived for us. And His perfection and good works is the lens through which God looks at us when we put our faith in Him. He certainly died to pay the penalty for our sins, but He also lived to give us a righteousness we could never live out ourselves. Join us this Wednesday as we begin Lent together.
