

Redemption Hill Deacons



The elders of Redemption Hill have recently approved a process for identifying and installing deacons who will serve in areas of need that will most impact and serve our Northside congregation. We are excited to see how God will use this to continue to grow and deepen Redemption Hill Church.

We ask that you would take time to read the qualifications for deacons found in [1 Timothy 3:8-12](#), and that you would prayerfully consider the following roles for any member you believe would serve well in that role.

• Deacon of Assimilation

The Deacon of Assimilation serves Redemption Hill by caring for those who are new to the Northside congregation. The role includes leading the assimilation team to help people move from first time guest, to covenant member.

• Deacon of Events

The Deacon of Events serves Redemption Hill by organizing and overseeing special events and trainings specific to the Northside congregation.

• Deacon of Marriage Coaching

The Deacon of Marriage Coaching serves Redemption Hill by helping Northside couples prepare for and meet the challenges of marriage by reminding each other of the gospel. This role includes leading a team of marriage coaches, and providing coaching to individual couples.

• Deacon of Mercy Ministry

The Deacon of Mercy Ministry serves Redemption Hill by ensuring Northside members who find themselves in unique life situations are served and cared for. This role includes developing ways for the congregation to know and serve needs within the church.

• Deacon of Sunday Hospitality

The Deacon of Sunday Hospitality serves Redemption Hill by helping ensure that everyone that comes on a Sunday morning is made to feel welcome. This role includes developing a team that leads the congregation in hospitality.

• Deacon of Sunday Services

The Deacon of Sunday Services serves Redemption Hill by leading and coordinating all aspects of what goes into making Sunday mornings possible. The role includes working with existing teams, and helping to develop new teams, to turn Holton Elementary into a wonderful space for our Northside congregation Sunday morning services.

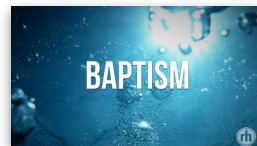
