In our continued efforts to make this building more usable and hospitable, we have a few projects currently underway:

- **Sanctuary Windows (Yard Side)** - the windows facing the side yard will be getting a facelift over the next 2 weeks.
- **Front Steps Lights** - we will also be addressing the (lack of) lighting on the front steps.
- **Blinds** - with a few exceptions, we now have blinds on all the windows downstairs (thank you Seth Seay).
- **Handrails** - the handrails leading down to the front foyer have also been fixed (thank you Dave Jackson).
- **Curtain Rods and Drapes** - curtain rods and drapes are also being installed on the windows in the K-1 and Equip rooms (thank you Dave Barrow).

Worship Notes



Today is Ascension Sunday on the Church calendar. The Church calendar is meant to reorient our lives around the timeline of Jesus Christ's own life and work. Forty days after Christ's resurrection (Acts 1:3), He ascended into heaven (Luke 24:51; Acts 1:1-11). Christ's ascension is not insignificant, because: 1. Christ did not leave earth through death (the ascension validates His resurrection); 2. it prefigures His return (it assures us that He will come again); 3. He is now seated at the right hand of the Father (it validates and seals His absolute authority, kingship, and sovereignty over this world). The church celebrates "Ascension Day" forty days after Easter, which always falls on a Thursday, and, this year, happened on May 30th. Ascension Sunday, the Sunday following, draws attention to this important event.
