Build My Life

Today we'll be introducing a new song to our gathering, *Build My Life* by Brett Younker, Karl Martin, Kirby Kable, Pat Barrett, and Matt Redman. This simple song is both devotional and missional. It confesses our complete dependence on God, while at the same time calling us to be the Church He has called us to be as it reinforces the worthiness of Jesus, the only foundation to build our lives upon. *Build My Life* invites us to worship Jesus for his preeminence (Colossians 1:15–20), his worthiness (Revelation 5:9), and his authority (Ephesians 1:21); while at the same time asking God to open our eyes ever wider to Himself and the people around us, not neglecting love for our neighbor. Our hope is that this song will remind us to daily surrender to Jesus, a way to see him building what only He can build in us: eyes that see him, hearts filled with the things He loves, and lives which seek to serve those around us.
